- 3.2 Standard work is required to be implemented at all sites where the standards apply.
- **3.3** Annually, each site is required to conduct an internal audit on all the standards and score their performance in Gensuite's Immersion Tracker.
- **3.4** Sites are audited on the standards at the frequency identified in the Audit standard work.
- **3.5** New standards are added once approved by the EHS Council and released to the broader EHS Community. Implementation of new standards is expected within 6 months of a new standard release.
- **3.6** This standard is not scored in Gensuite Immersion Tracker.
